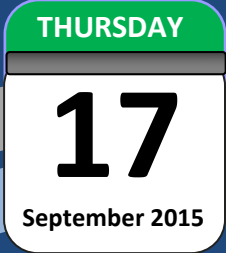

His many achievements include 2012 Dutch Sourcing Award for best overall procurement effort and operational excellence, 2011 Silver Award from NASPO (implementation of best value PIPS at the State of Idaho), and 2009 Excellence Educator Award for his numerous accomplishments in education and research. He has authored several books and journal publications. Prior to ASU, Dean was a Project Engineer for the US Air Force during his 14 years of military service.

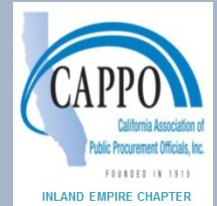
